

Environmental Policy

It is Perfect Pipework's Ltd Policy to take full account of any environmental implications of our operation, and to protect the natural environment.

Specifically PPL aims to :-

1. Identify and assess any actions in our operations, which contravene any known environmental statutory requirements and codes of practice.
2. Continually improve on these actions to achieve compliance with the spirit as well as the letter of environmental legislation.
3. Encourage among personnel, suppliers and the general business community, an understanding of any relevant environmental issues in the context of our industry.

Site Waste Management Regulations:

All PPL staff and sub-contractors are expected to comply with the requirements of the Site Waste Management Plan of the site as follows:-

1. All operatives and supervisors must attend the site inductions where the SWMP will be explained.
2. Collect up and store waste as required by the SWMP.
3. Where PPL are disposing of the waste then take any waste produced to the designated collection points. Where segregated skips/containers are provided then ensure the waste is placed in the correct skip/container. If waste is placed in the wrong skip/container this can result in increased disposal costs which will be charged to the relevant sub-contractor.
4. Any sub-contractor who is responsible for disposing of their own waste will store it in the designate area(s) prior to collection. Before any waste is removed from the site the sub-contractor must provide the following information to PPL:
 - a) the identity of the person removing the waste.
 - b) the waste carrier registration number of the carrier.
 - c) a copy of, or reference to, the written description of the waste required by section 34 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990; and
 - d) the name and location of site that the waste is being taken to and the number of the licence the operator of that site holds under the Environmental Permitting (England & Wales) Regulations 2007, or if registered under those Regulations as a waste operation exempt from the need for such a permit then full details of that exemption including a copy of the notice issued to the Environmental Agency claiming that exemption.
 - e) The Waste Management Action is as follows:
 - a. re-used (and whether this was on or off site);
 - b. recycled (and whether this was on or off site);
 - c. sent for another form of recovery (and whether this was on or off site);
 - d. sent to landfill; or
 - e. otherwise disposed of.
